

**MINUTES**  
**ANNUAL TOWN MEETING**  
**TUESDAY APRIL 15, 2014**

**7:00 P.M.**

Matters of Business are as follows:

1. **Call to order** – 7:00 P.M. .
2. **Pledge of Allegiance** – Recited.
3. **Approval of Minutes from the April 16, 2013 Annual Meeting** – Motion by Al Bensemam and a second by Steve Musinsky. Vote by count of hands 12 Ayes and 0 Nays. Motion carried.
4. **Report on 2013 Lake Patrol & Town of Hartford Police Activities presented by Police Chief Tim Rohrer.** – Chief Rohrer stated the following for 2013: 3 new officers were hired in 2013 which required 80 hours of training. Officer Mistele went through basic training at his cost. The boat audit went well. The department took part in building two life jacket loaner stations at Pike Lake. Culvers donated free custard certificates to the patrol to hand out for good boating rewards. The patrol had two boater safety classes in 2013. Personal flotation devices were purchased for each officer on Lake Patrol. The department worked with Tina on dog license violations. The department also trained the Village of Iron Ridge Police Department in EVOC training. Officer Mike Koester was awarded a commendation for safety practices. Assistant Chief Jim Koerber, St Lawrence Fire Department, gave the following report for 2013: The department had 98 calls in 2013. There are presently 43 members on the department and 15 first responders. The department built a grass rig for grass fires. The annual picnic was very successful. Auto aid with the Allenton department is working out very well.
5. **Chairman's Report – Overview of 2013** – See attached report.
6. **Question and answer session from the public to the Town Board.** – Al Bensemam asked the Board if there was anything happening with the law suit filed against the Town. He was told that depositions on both sides were being taken at the present time. Steve Musinsky asked about the salt usage for the Town. The Board told him that the Town was using a 50/50 mix of sand and salt which has worked out well for the Town. Arnie Fehring asked about the empty lot on Shady Lane. The Board stated that the Town offered to buy the lot but that the price was outrageous. Dick Indermuhle stated that the road crew guys work very hard and should in some way be compensated for all there efforts.
7. **Any other business that may properly come before the meeting per WI State Statutes 60.10** – Al Bensemam made a motion to compensate Clerk, Marvin Justman and Treasurer, Tina Pfeifer with a \$1000 bonus each for all the extra hours they have

been putting in for the Town. A second was received from John Jung. Vote by count of hands, 12 Ayes and 0 Nays. Motion carried.

8. **Adjournment** – Motion by Al Bensemman and a second by Jim Brown. Vote by count of hands, 12 Ayes and 0 Nays. Motion carried.
