

**MINUTES**  
**ANNUAL TOWN MEETING**  
**TUESDAY APRIL 19, 2016**

Matters of Business are as follows:

1. **Call to order.** – 7:00 P.M.
2. **Pledge of Allegiance** – Recited.
3. **Approval of Minutes from the April 21, 2015 Annual Meeting.** – Motion by Al Bensemman to approve and a second by Gene Hoerth. Motion carried unanimously.
4. **Report from any municipal Fire Department serving the Town of Hartford.** – None.
5. **Report on 2015 Lake Patrol & Town of Hartford Police Activities presented by Police Chief Tim Rohrer.** – Chief Tim Rohrer reported the following: One police officer left the force and one was hired in 2015. The department did a small amount of traffic control, and some dog license follow-up. The Lake Patrol did 536 hours of patrolling in 2015. They wrote a number of warnings and citations. The Lake Patrol sponsored a mock boat accident which involved numerous jurisdictions. The police department sponsored a taser training course at the Town Hall. The department also held a community outreach program along with snowmobile training and boater safety training. Jon Binsfeld from the Washington County Sheriff's Department introduced himself as liaison for the Town of Hartford. He stated that he will become the communication line between the Town and the County.
6. **Chairman's Report – Overview of 2015.** – See attached report.
7. **Question and answer session from the public to the Town Board.** – Steve Musinsky asked if there was anything new with the reliever route. Dave Kainz asked whether the Town was aware that the County was thinking about selling the golf course. He also stated that he would be very disappointed if that would happen. Dave Kainz also asked the board if the new erosion control and stormwater controls had gone into effect. Dave Kainz complimented the Town Board for the work they do for the constituents of the Town.
